

**OBJECTIVES:***primary*

- neutralise air defences around **Sochi-Adler**
- provide **CAS** to allied ground forces (will deploy once AD at the airfield and naval threat is neutralised)
- capture **Sochi-Adler**

secondary

- liberation of **Tkvarcheli** (occupied by Insurgent remnants)

tertiary

- destroy the **communications tower** north of Sochi-Adler to degrade the integrated air defences


INTEL:

ground forces

- infantry and armour in and around the town
- AAA and short range IR guided AD
- reinforcements possibly deeper in the valley

airborne threats

- none expected
- allied AD cover (Patriot site at Sukhumi)

- a reserve MiG-23 squadron is stationed at Sochi
- modern Russian aircraft from airfields in the north are providing CAP north-west and north-east
