BREAKING NEWS

The government of Iraq has accepted ISIS leadership, the office of Prime Minister Abdul Rahman Arif announced today. In conjunction with the Iranian ruining council, they have united and established the Persian Republic of the Islamic Caliphate. Which encompasses the former territories of Iraq and Iran. Upon announcement, they promptly shut down access to the Strait of Hormuz and the Arabian Gulf and declared 50nm from shore as territorial waters, and the entire airspace over the gulf under PRIC control. All commercial Sea Traffic into the area has halted.

Civilian Air traffic is still being permitted in Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, UAE, and Oman airspace. For now. -BBC News, Oct 14th

The people of Iraq in exerting their own right of self governance have chosen new leadership. The president wishes to extend a welcome to the new leaders of the Persian Republic of the Islamic Caliphate to the world stage and hopes to establish diplomatic communication with them soon. HUMINT source [REDACTED] reports that Prime Minister Abdul Rahman Arif was assassinated the day ISIS took over the Iraqi government. Status of immediate family members is currently unknown, but believed to be hidden by supporters and being smuggled out of the country.

All US American personnel have until 12:00p 18 OCT (0900Z 18-OCT) to leave the Islamic Republic, or they will be arrested, tried and executed as Spies. Any hostile actions taken in that time will be considered an act of war and all remaining people will be arrested, tried and executed as spies. You will not get another warning.

On 140CT, shortly after the announcement of the establishment of PRIC, a US State Dept flight with members of the Senate Intelligence Committee, was flying over the Persian Gulf area when they were intercepted by PRIC AF fighters. The flight was being escorted by 2 USMC F/A-18C Fighters. Upon being intercepted the flight declared an emergency on guard, and then went silent. US alert fighters (194nd FS F-15C's) at Al Dahfra AFB, Dubai, were immediately scrambled.

All attempts to re-establish contact were unsuccessful.

As the alert fighters approached the area they saw several fireballs fall to the ocean and hit the water. As they got closer, they were intercepted by PRIC AF fighters, and ordered away.

They were ordered not to engage and leave the area. Those orders came direct from the National Command Authority. The incident was declared Classified and all parties held to US national espionage act and reassigned.

Since the establishment of The Islamic Caliphate 6 months ago, the PRIC government has solidified complete control of all Sea lanes and Air Space in the Persian Gulf Area, including the Strait of Hormuz.

They are enforcing this action with Air Defence sites spread out on all the Islands in the Gulf as well as shore based sites, all linked as an Integrated Air Defense network with shore based Long Range Early Warning Radars. Consisting of multiple SA-2's, 5's & 10's long range Surface to Air Missile systems. SA-8's, 11's, 15's, 19's & HAWK short range SAM systems. As well as numerous anti-aircraft artillery systems.

Silkworm Anti-Ship batteries, and a robust fleet of littoral ships consisting of Corvette's and Fast Attack Boats are being used to enforce the control of the Sea Lanes.

The recently sworn in President has tasked Task Force Dagger in conjunction with other allied assets with ending this threat. Permanently. The NCA considers the intentional shoot down of sitting members of the US Senate and US servicemen as an act of war, and is ordering actions accordingly.

****Phase 1 briefing****

Objective -

1-Re-establish Air Dominance over Gulf and Strait of Hormuz

2-Re-establish freedom of Navigation in Persian

3-Gulf and Strait of Hormuz area waters Protect American and Allied assets in the region

Air Superiority Flights pressing into the strait and Gulf while flights attack with DEAD mission load out and eliminate SAMs and Silkworm sites.

-ALL SAM sites and Silkworm sites within the strait and Gulf area to 15nm inland from coastline along the former Iranian coast are to be destroyed and/or rendered mission incapable.

-ALL PRIC Navy Fast Attack Boats to be destroyed.

-Bandar Abbas to be rendered incapable of supporting offensive operations in the future.

-Establish Forward Operating Base at Abu Musa Island

Once threats on that airfield are destroyed, C17's will do a low altitude tactical drop and place a US Army Rangers occupying force, including mobile AD units, in those locations to secure for allied support of air operations.






Bandar Abbas Airfield Waypoint 5
